

Durham Public Schools 2016 Bond Project Descriptions

Elementary Schools

<u>Bethesda Elementary School</u>	\$187,500
Bethesda will receive an LED light upgrade along with security upgrades.	
<u>Burton Elementary School</u>	\$687,500
Burton is receiving roofing through the lottery. This bond will provide HVAC upgrades along with strategic security measures. Burton also received an LED lighting upgrade recently.	
<u>Club Boulevard Elementary School</u>	\$1,062,500
Club will receive a significant roofing upgrade along with an LED lighting improvement. Club will also receive strategic security measures.	
<u>Creekside Elementary School</u>	\$118,750
A recent addition was built at Creekside. The school's only need at this time is upgrades to security measures.	
<u>Easley Elementary School</u>	\$62,500
Easley will have security enhancements to the entry area.	
<u>Eastway Elementary School</u>	\$575,000
Eastway will receive an upgrade to its chillers, security upgrades and an LED lighting upgrade.	
<u>Eno Valley Elementary School</u>	\$7,3320,194
Eno Valley will undergo a full campus renovation, improving traffic, security, HVAC and other features. Exterior corridors will be enclosed.	
<u>Fayetteville St. Elementary School</u>	\$118,750
Fayetteville St. was expanded and renovated in the previous bond. Currently, only security upgrades are planned.	
<u>Forest View Elementary School</u>	\$1,812,500
Forest View will receive a full roofing upgrade as well as new security measures.	
<u>Glenn Elementary School</u>	\$118,750
Glenn will receive new security upgrades.	
<u>Harris Elementary School</u>	\$1,062,500
Harris was previously expanded and renovated. Partial roofing replacement will occur along with new security measures.	

<u>Hillandale Elementary School</u>	\$343,750
Work at Hillandale will include HVAC upgrades and security measures.	
<u>Holt Elementary School</u>	\$1,251,106
Holt will have strategic roofing work along with a new freezer/cooler in the kitchen. An LED lighting upgrade and security measures are also included.	
<u>Hope Valley Elementary School</u>	\$353,750
Hope Valley will receive HVAC upgrades and security measures.	
<u>Lakewood Elementary School</u>	\$300,000
Lakewood requires a new boiler and security upgrades.	
<u>Little River Elementary School</u>	\$343,750
Little River requires a new chiller and security upgrades.	
<u>Mangum Elementary School</u>	\$112,500
Mangum will receive security measures and an LED lighting upgrade.	
<u>Merrick-Moore Elementary School</u>	\$1,307,500
Work will include a cafeteria and kitchen renovation as well as new equipment. Security measures and an LED lighting upgrade are also included.	
<u>Morehead Elementary School</u>	\$118,750
Expanded and renovated in a previous bond, Morehead is slated for security measures only.	
<u>Oak Grove Elementary School</u>	\$1,812,500
Planned for Oak Grove are full roofing replacement and security upgrades.	
<u>Parkwood Elementary School</u>	\$515,000
Partial roofing upgrades, boiler replacement and security measures are planned for Parkwood.	
<u>Pearson Elementary School</u>	\$87,500
Strategic security measures are intended for Pearson.	
<u>Pearsontown Elementary School</u>	\$875,000
The front corridor requires a structural renovation to the floor. Other work includes security upgrades.	
<u>Powe Elementary School</u>	\$637,500
A chiller upgrade and security measures are planned for Powe.	
<u>Sandy Ridge Elementary School</u>	\$0
As a very new school, no work is planned for Sandy Ridge.	

<u>Smith Elementary School</u>	\$0
Smith was expanded and fully renovated in the previous bond.	
<u>Southwest Elementary School</u>	\$62,500
Roofing is currently underway from lottery funds. This bond includes only security measures.	
<u>Spaulding Elementary School</u>	\$825,000
Spaulding will have a partial roofing upgrade, a chiller replacement and security measures.	
<u>Spring Valley Elementary School</u>	\$87,500
Still a very new school, only security measures are planned.	
<u>Watts Elementary School</u>	\$625,000
Strategic roofing and chiller upgrades will be received along with security measures.	

Middle Schools

<u>Brogden Middle School</u>	\$187,500
Brogden will receive additional renovations to the main gymnasium to complement the new bleachers funded by the 2007 bond. Brogden will also have security measures and upgrades.	
<u>Carrington Middle School</u>	\$237,500
Carrington will receive additional renovations to the main gymnasium to complement the new bleachers funded by the 2007 bond. Carrington will also have security measures and upgrades.	
<u>Githens Middle School</u>	\$62,500
Githens will receive security measures such as an entry vestibule and door access controls.	
<u>Lakewood Middle Montessori School</u>	\$0
Lakewood Middle is a very new school and does not have significant capital needs at this time.	
<u>Lowe's Grove Middle School</u>	\$1,593,750
Lowe's Grove will receive additional renovations to the main gymnasium to complement the new bleachers funded by the 2007 bond. Lowe's Grove will also have security measures and upgrades. Lastly, a significant roofing upgrade is planned.	
<u>Lucas Middle School</u>	\$62,500
Lucas is a very new school and only requires an upgrade to security measures.	
<u>Neal Middle School</u>	\$206,250
Neal will receive additional renovations to the main gymnasium to complement the new bleachers funded by the 2007 bond. Neal will also have security measures and upgrades.	

Rogers-Herr Middle School **\$287,500**

Rogers-Herr will receive an LED lighting upgrade and a replacement of the fire alarm system. The school will also receive strategic security upgrades.

Shepard Middle School **\$87,500**

Shepard was recently expanded and fully renovated. Only security upgrades are planned for Shepard.

High Schools and Secondary Schools

City of Medicine Academy **\$25,000**

This facility is extremely new and only requires an upgrade to the door access system.

Holton Career & Resource Center **\$62,500**

Holton was fully renovated in recent years and only requires security camera upgrades. Also, the city and DPS contribute capital funds as part of the joint use agreement.

Durham School of the Arts **\$2,700,000**

DSA will receive renovations to rest rooms and locker rooms, especially in the main gym. Other upgrades include roofing replacement and security measures.

Early College High School **\$62,500**

At Early College, NCCU currently maintains the capital needs of the building. DPS will upgrade the security camera system.

Hillside / New Tech High School **\$1,237,500**

Several athletic features will be improved such as locker room renovations, track repairs and tennis lights. Some rest room renovations are also included along with security upgrades.

Jordan High School **\$1,897,500**

Several athletic features will be improved such as locker room renovations, track repairs and tennis lights. Some rest room renovations are also included along with security upgrades. In addition, some roofing replacement is planned and the kitchen's cooler/freezer will be replaced.

Lakeview School **\$162,500**

In addition to upgrading security measures, Lakeview will receive an LED lighting upgrade.

Northern High School **\$51,875,000**

Northern will be replaced and built new on the existing site due to its age, condition and need for modernization.

Riverside High School **\$1,195,625**

Several athletic features will be improved such as locker room renovations, track repairs and tennis lights. Some rest room renovations are also included along with security upgrades.

School for Creative Studies **\$350,000**
Interior science room renovations will resolve code and instructional issues. Upgrades to the fire alarm system and security measures are also included.

Southern School of Energy and Sustainability **\$1,196,250**
Several athletic features will be improved such as locker room renovations, track repairs and tennis lights. Some rest room renovations are also included along with security upgrades. Paving near the bus lot and drives will improve the function and appearance for system buses.

Central Services

Bacon Street Central Services **\$15,000**
Work at Bacon Street includes security measures.

Fuller Building Central Services **\$550,625**
Fuller's roof requires replacement. Also, an LED lighting upgrade and security measures are included.

Hamlin Road Central Services **\$1,046,250**
The roofing system will be replaced. An LED lighting upgrade will also complement the security measures planned.

Hamlin Road Operations Center **\$125,000**
Work here will focus on security upgrades.

Pearson Central Services **\$232,450**
An allowance for renovation is provided to complete necessary work until the facility is sold.

Staff Development Center **\$481,250**
Roofing, LED lighting and security upgrades are all intended for Staff Development Center

HUB Farm **\$375,000**
The HUB farm will receive a new barn structure and rest rooms.

Other Services

Bond Support Services **\$900,000**
Bond support includes project management, third-party services such as cost analysis, scheduling, financial tracking and more.
