

Dear Prospective Scholarship Applicant:

Since 2009, the Durham General Davie Chapter of the North Carolina Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution (NCSAR) has awarded a merit-based scholarship to a college bound senior girl. Named after the late Kathrine R. Everett, a trailblazing lawyer and community leader, all applicants **MUST** be a resident of Durham County and enrolled in an accredited public, charter, or private school. A North Carolina School of Science and Math applicant must be a resident of Durham County. A home-schooled daughter or granddaughter of an active General Davie Chapter member is also eligible. The scholarship candidate will have demonstrated outstanding academic performance and leadership skills over her high school career. Average GPA of recent candidates - unweighted 3.83, weighted 4.25; 5-10 honors and/or AP classes.

This year we have increased the scholarship amount from \$1000 to \$1500!
