QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) Is a graduating senior from a public school in a county where a member of the DVAMWMW resides.
- (2) Has been accepted to a regionally accredited historically black college or university (HBCU) or a regionally accredited community college.
- (3) Is the first person in the immediate family (parents and siblings) who will go to a post-secondary institution.
- (4) Has at least a 2.0 (C average) in a high school academic program with college preparatory courses.
- (5) Is an active member of a church.
- (6) Can document financial need.
- (7) Is available for at least one interview with the Scholarship Committee of the DVAMWMW.

AWARDS: Awards will be made directly to the student upon proof of enrollment: \$500.00 for 1st semester and \$500.00 for the 2nd semester, provided that a 2.0 GPA or higher is achieved during the 1st semester.

- (2) Attach a copy of your official high school transcript and a current headshot photograph. A JPEG file is acceptable.
- (3) Provide two letters of reference: (1) a high school teacher and (2) the applicant's pastor, youth minister, *or* auxiliary advisor. Persons providing references must not be related to the applicant. Letters may be sent to the postal or email address on this letterhead. Mailed letters must be postmarked by March 25, 2025, and emailed letters must be received by March 31, 2025.
