The program, which is open to current sophomores and juniors is located at High Point University and Meredith College. Students are expected to be able to blend intellectual discussion with practical application of theory.

### **AREA DESCRIPTIONS**

- <u>Area I</u> is the area of a student's special interest on which the student is chosen to attend Governor's School
- <u>Current I I th graders</u> may be nominated for the following areas: English, Spanish, French, Mathematics, Natural Science, Social Science, Art, Choral Music, Instrumental Music, Dance, Theater
- <u>Current 10th graders</u> may be nominated for the following areas only: Choral Music, Instrumental Music, Dance

## A MESSAGE FROM Governor's School Alum!

### ELIGIBILITY

- You must meet the achievement criterion as established by the Board of Governors for the North Carolina Governor's School. This means a national percentile score of 92% or above on an approved achievement test OR a state percentile score of 92% or above on an allowable North Carolina End-of-Course (EOC) Test
- See your counselor to confirm you meet Governor's School Eligibility Requirements!
  - Testing If you do not meet the 92 percentile cutoff, there is an option to test. You must see Ms.
    Machak ASAP in Student Services or by email <u>Sarah.Machak@dpsnc.net</u>.

### **IMPORTANT DATES**

- October 30<sup>th</sup> Applications due to Ms. Machak in Student Services by 4:15pm (for review)
- November 1<sup>st</sup> Last chance applications will be due by 4:15pm
  - Applications submit on November 1<sup>st</sup> that are missing components may not be eligible to submit to the district. Students should confirm they have all components before submitting on this date.
- November 15<sup>th</sup> Final nominations sent to state

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- I. Basic Information and Nomination Discipline
- 2. Essays (Essay #1 everyone responds, Essay #2 specific to nomination area)
  - I. Follow the instructions
  - 2. Understand the prompts
  - 3. Do your own work
- 3. Personal Readiness (activities, awards, and experience that have prepared you)
  - I. This is the section where you describe what makes you ready for a summer residential experience.
- 4. <u>TWO</u> Recommendations

### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Family members may not complete/submit recommendations.
- At least one recommendation must be from a high school teacher, preferably in the nomination area. If a nomination-area teacher is not available, choose another teacher.
- Recommenders should download the Recommendation Form and complete it electronically. Upon completion, the recommender should print the form, sign it, place it in a sealed envelope and submit it to you or the appropriate local school official. You, as the student, should not read it.
- Only two Recommendation Forms will be accepted. No other documents (e.g., substitute letters, additional recommendations, etc.) will be accepted.
- Please note that recommendations MUST be completed electronically. Handwritten or attached letters WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. NO MORE THAN TWO FORMS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED PER STUDENT. The Governor's School will not consider them and it holds up the process.

### HELPFUL TIPS FOR YOUR Application

- Nomination Discipline Pick something that you are both capable and passionate about
- Essays Start working on your essays long before they are due; last-minute efforts usually are not fruitful. Also, there is not a 'correct answer' to the essay prompts. Readers are wanting to gain insight into how you think about these topics, not just what you think.
- Personal Readiness List those activities, awards and experiences that demonstrate your readiness and fitness for the Governor's School experience. Leadership, dedication and a willingness to take on challenges are good qualities.
- Recommendations Find those who can 1) be honest and 2) speak well of you. Also, high ratings alone are usually insufficient; additional input in the free-response sections help support the ratings. Our readers often have more confidence in well-supported 'Very Good' marks than unsupported 'Superior' marks.

### HELPFUL TIPS FOR YOUR Application

#### • Student Email – page I of the Student Application

- Use email you check regularly. DPS email cannot accept responses unless you fix that in the settings
- For arts programs that require auditions, information about auditions is sent to this email
- Essay #1 "PROMPT: Identify and discuss one or more of the most pressing questions you have about how the world works. How are you planning to pursue answers?"
  - Students need to address both parts of this prompt (A: identify and discuss.... B: plans to pursue answers) Last year, many students only identified and discussed, but gave little or no attention to how they planned to pursue answers.

#### Personal Readiness

- This section has been divided into three columns (School, Community, and Awards/Honors) and the student is asked to use bulleted lists.
- Organizing the list with headers is helpful (Freshman Year, Sophomore Year, Junior Year OR by activities.
- If the student is using an acronym or an activity reviewers may not be familiar with, please have them identify.
  - Example: Duke SPLASH (interactive seminars by Duke students)
