## 1 Cohort Graduation Rate

This Cohort Graduation Rate (CGR) is the measure of the percentage of students at each high school who graduate within the four-year expected time frame. According to Durham Public Schools' 5-year Strategic Plan, the district's (CGR) overall goal for 2020-21 was 86.4%. This year's rate surpassed that goal by 0.4 percentage points.
