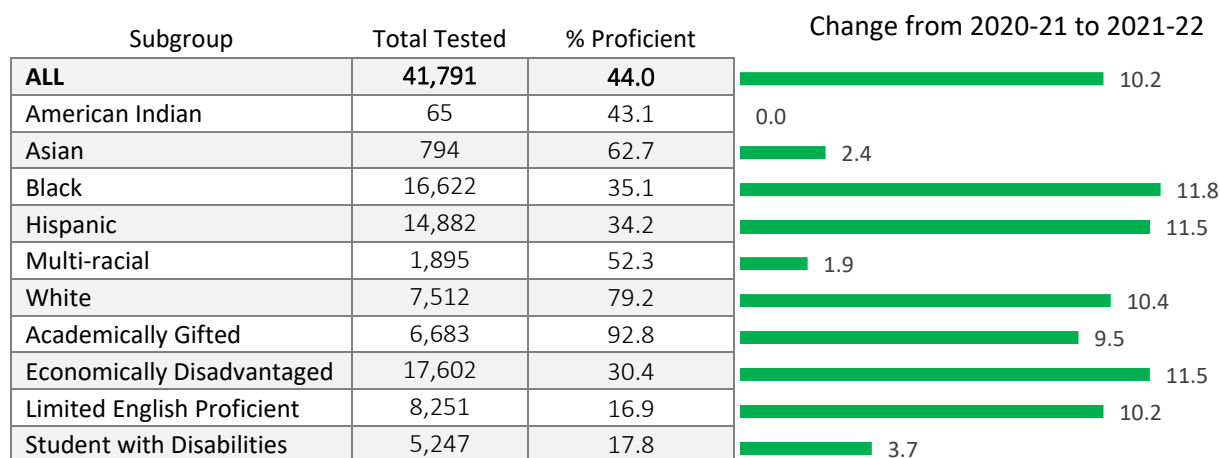


Overview

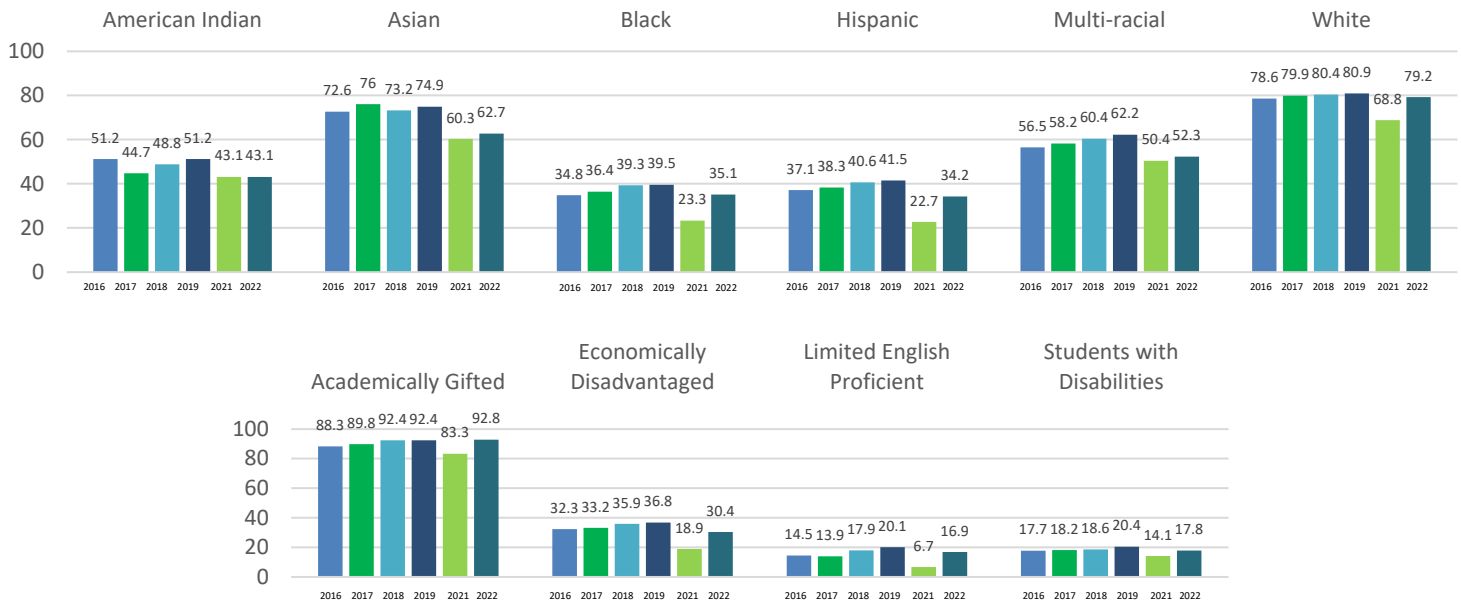
