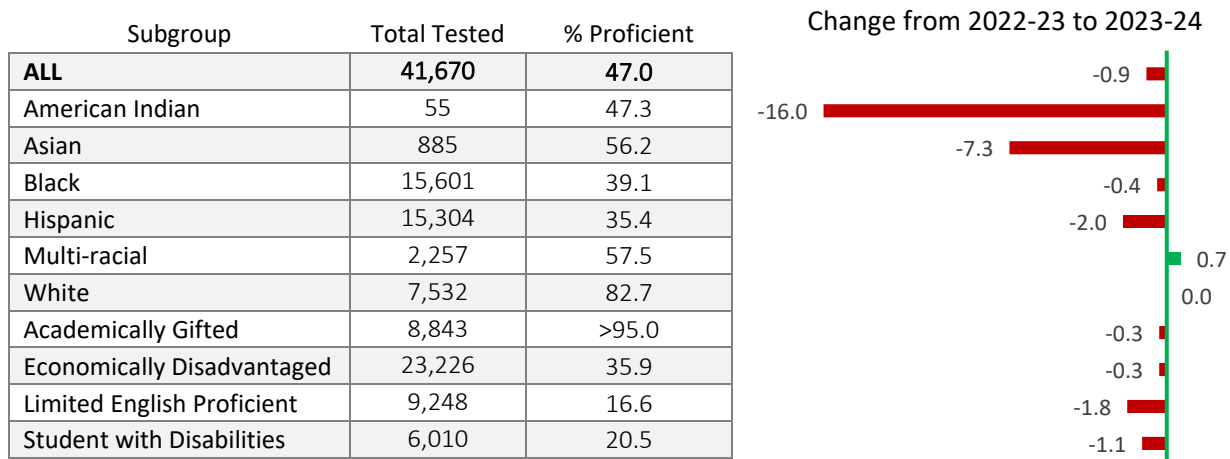

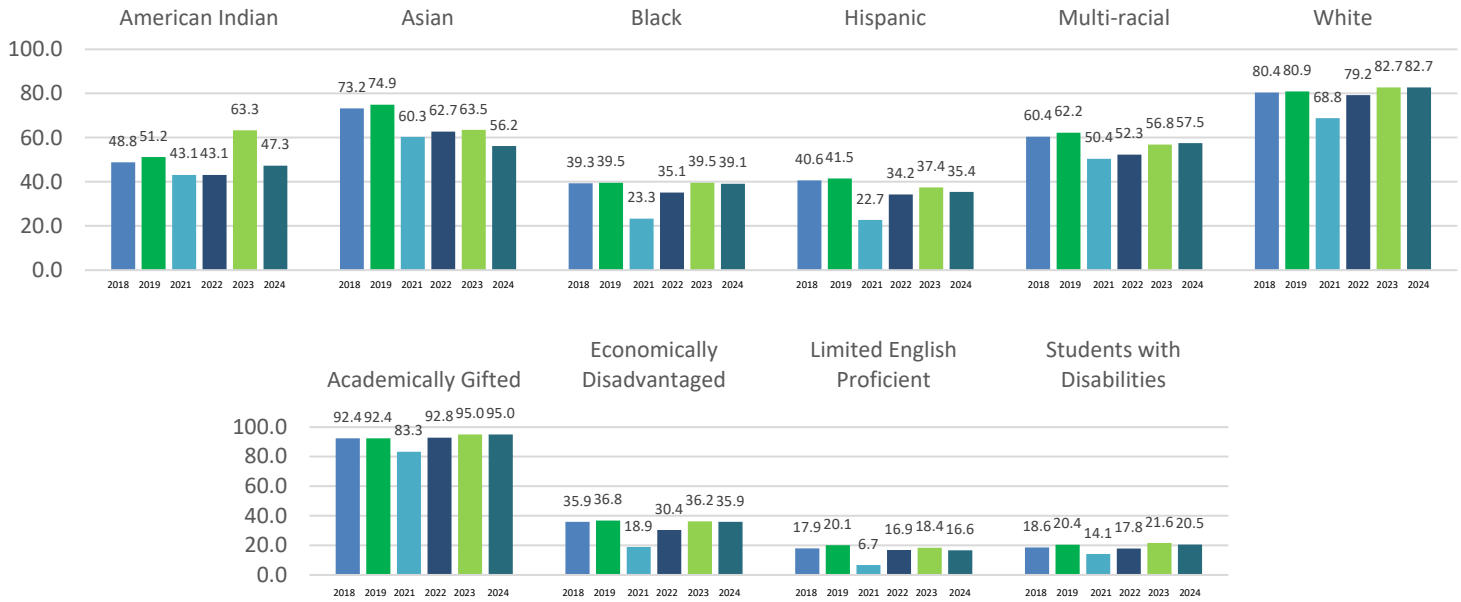

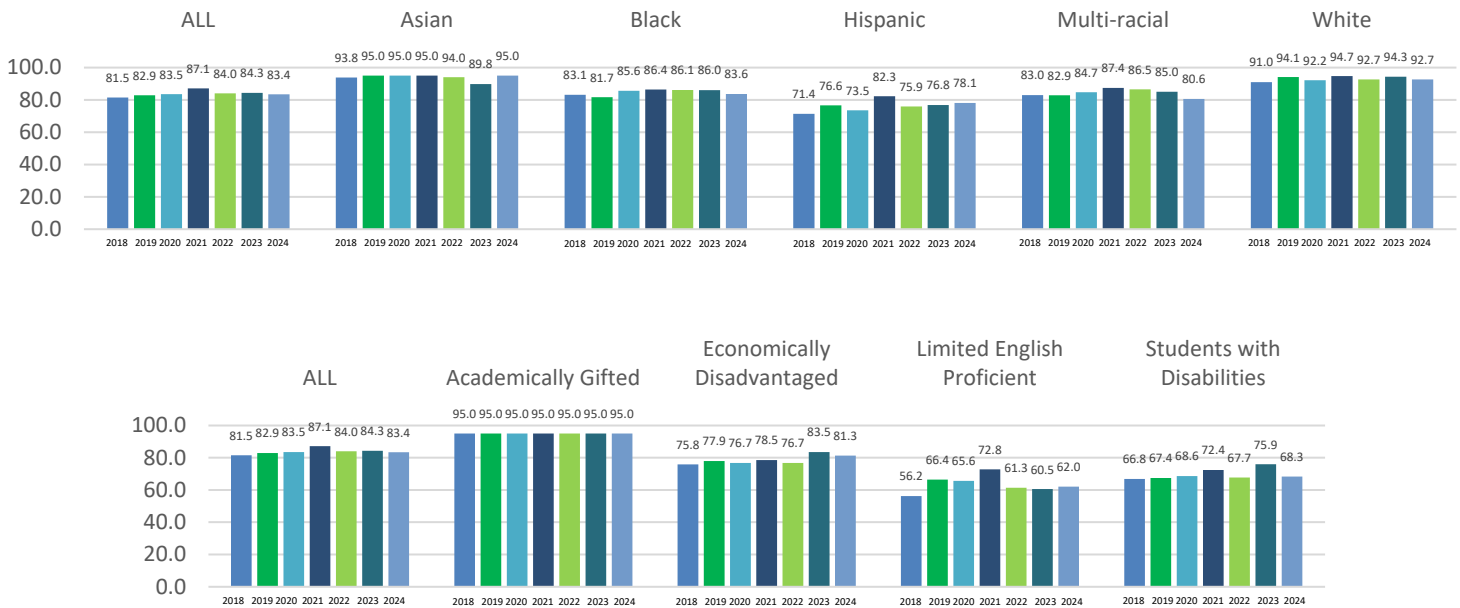
4 COMPOSITE SUBGROUP COMPARISON OVER TIME
