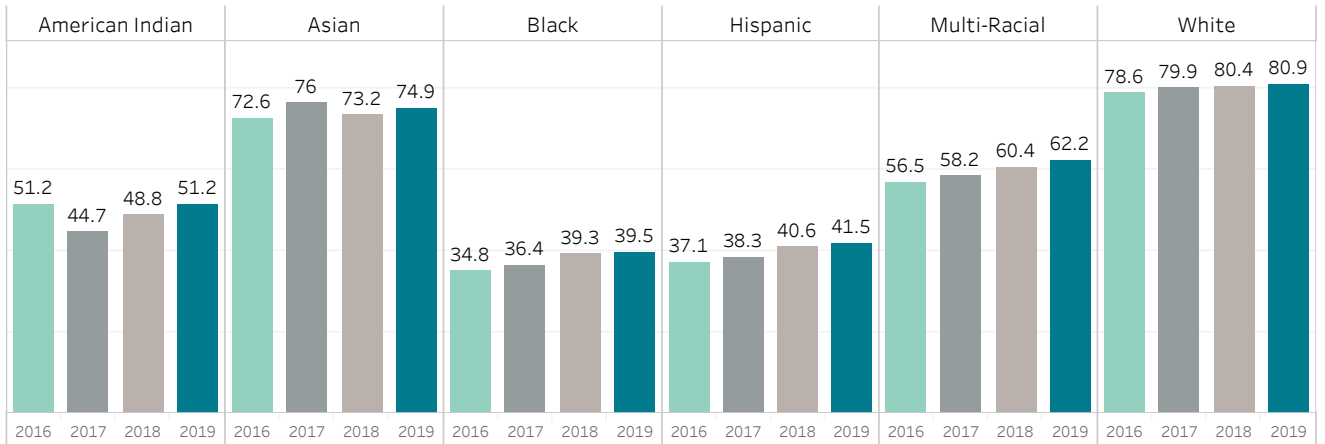

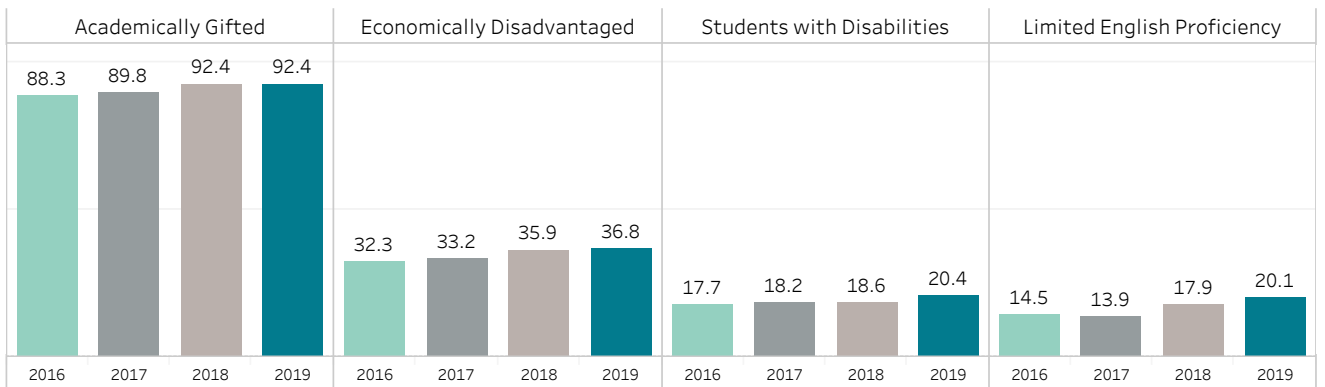
4 DISTRICT-LEVEL COMPOSITE SUBGROUP COMPARISON OVER TIME

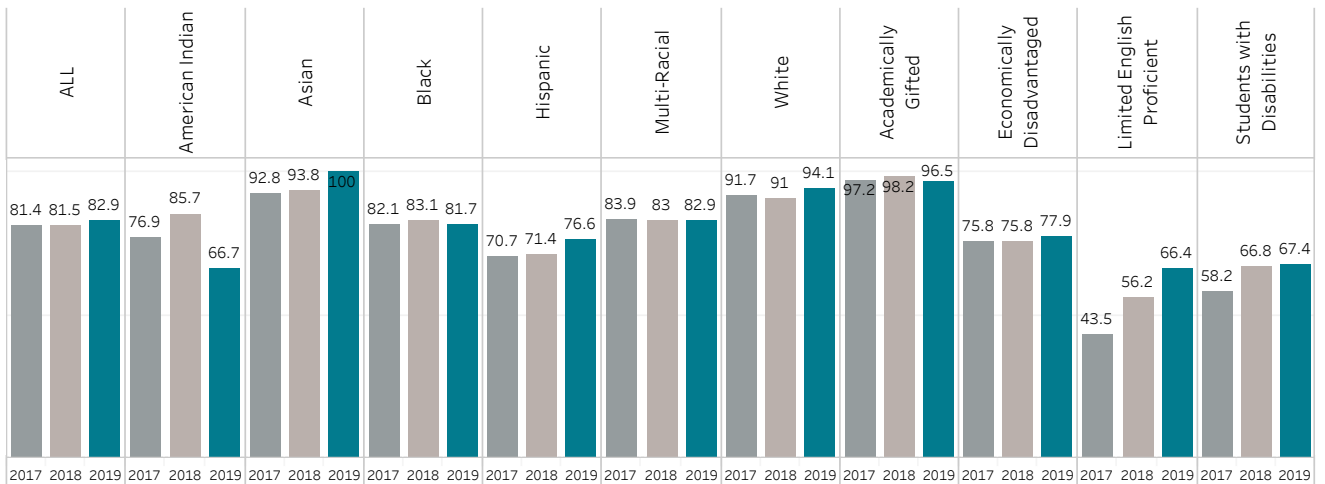
5 DISTRICT-LEVEL COMPOSITE SUBGROUP COMPARISON OVER TIME
