I/We understand that the device/hotspot and its accessory equipment (battery, power cord) are the property of Durham Public Schools.

I/We understand that the student, with the support of the parent/guardian, is responsible for the daily care and maintenance of the device(s) (this includes various accessories such as the battery, and power cord).

I/We understand that I/we must report all device damages, or the theft/loss of the device to school administration and DPS Information Technology (ITSupport@dpsnc.net) the next school day.

I/We understand and agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the *DPS Technology Responsible**Use Policy* and guidelines outlined in the *One-to-One (1:1) Student Device Handbook*. Failure to abide by these policy/guidelines will result in disciplinary action.
