Decrease based on final expenses and realignment of the budget for FY 2014-15 use based on constuction/renovation needs.

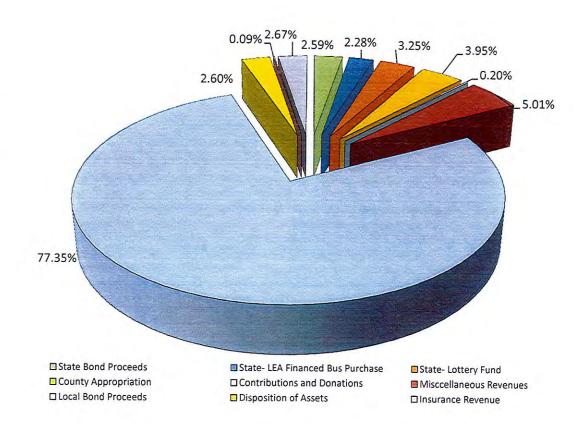

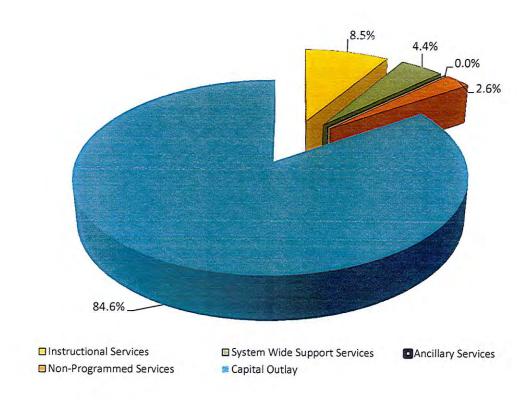

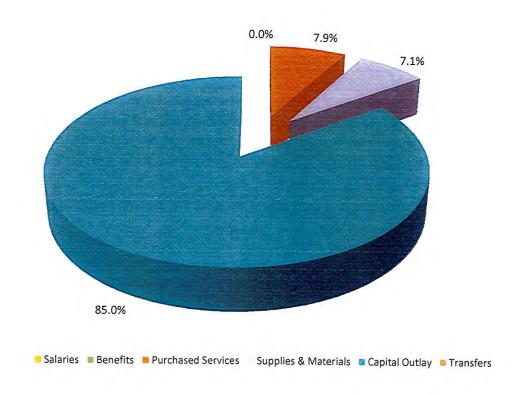
