Applying to College

COMMONAPP.ORG

- Online applications to over 700 colleges and universities
- Students provide teacher and counselor email.
 Information for online recommendations and online transcript submissions (be sure to contact desired recommender before you submit his/her name)
- Recommendation Letter- Brag Sheet
 - CFNC.ORG (College Foundation of North Carolina)
- Students can apply to colleges and submit transcripts electronically.
- Student must submit all information as it appears on his/her transcript and include student number.
- On Individual Colleges' Websites

When to Apply to College/University

-Varies; Please check the college/university's website for the deadline.

EARLY DECISION- Early decision plans are binding:
 A student who is accepted as an ED applicant must attend the college; apply between Nov 1 and 15 and receive a decision in Dec.

• EARLY ACTION- Early action plans are non-binding: Students receive an early response to their application but do not have to commit to the college until the normal reply date of May 1; apply between Nov.1-Nov. 15 and will receive a decision in Jan or Feb.

When to Apply to College/University

-Varies; Please check the college/university's website for the deadline.

 REGULAR DECISION- Regular Decision is the regular application deadline, early Jan-mid Feb., and you will receive your admission decision in the spring – usually around late-March into early-April.

 ROLLING DECISION/ADMISSION- Rolling admission means colleges review applications as they're sent in; there is no hard deadline by which you need to submit your application.

Requirements for UNC School System

- Minimum 2.5 GPA or minimum test score on the ACT (19) or SAT (1010)
- Core course requirements (26 hours)

NOTE: Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission. Research various colleges/universities' admission requirements.

Transcript Request

- Official school transcript includes:
 - -All EOG and EOC Scores
 - -All Final Grades
- *Transcripts are updated 2X a year.

(**NOTE:** SAT & ACT scores are **not** on the transcript. You must submit them electronically through College Board/SAT.org or ACT.org.)

Scholarships

-Remind parents to provide Scholarships/College Acceptance

- A number of scholarships (local & national) become available throughout the school year.
- Two main types: civic & college-related.
- These scholarships will be posted in the Scholarship/Resource Folder (Mrs. Ross-Gunter) and updated throughout the year, along with announcements via email and Counselor's Cafe in Canvas.
